





Audience Overview - Total Users

9,081 user logins were recorded visiting the site at an average of 174 per week 5,823 of those user logins were unique 149,430 page views at an average of 409 pages viewed per day Users spend on average 9 minutes and 57 seconds per session on the site.




Audience Overview - Total Users last 12 months

Australia makes up 59.68% of the audience as expected, within Australia 60% of the traffic comes from W.A.




Audience Overview - Technology


- 98.99% of users are using the 5 major browsers that we targeted when developing the website.

Audience Overview – Age & Gender


- 9,081 user logins were recorded visiting the site at an average of 174 per week

Audience Overview – Acquisition (how they get there)

- 71.6% of users visited from a referral website. (e.g.: www.ga.gov.au)
- 23% of users visited via a direct link (e.g.: A bookmark or entering the link into a browser)
- 5.3% of users visited via an organic search. (Not clear as labelled undefined)
- < 1% of users visited via Social Media (Facebook)



Audience Overview – Referrals (how they get there)

- 91.38% of users were directed from the GA website showing that most people were visiting there first.
- Appears to be several links to the website from other government departments and organisations as well but only make up a small number overall.


- Wells makes up approx. 43% of page visits





Which Documents are Downloaded


Statistics can be run to show which documents were downloaded the most








